Chief Hill is asking approval of the Board of Directors for the addition of 6 – 12 RFL Ambassador Volunteers (non-Fire Fighters) to be trained by Larimer County and be covered under the RFL FPD's Insurance to help CWPP (Community Wildfire Protection Plan) to help the RFL FPD assist RFL homeowners to evaluate properties for fire safety, in the Home Ignition Zone (HIZ). This program has been up and running in Crystal Lakes, Glacier View Meadows, Livermore, & Poudre Canyon, Bobby is hoping to get this program up & running in RFL this season. The people that go out to the properties need to be insured and part of an organization in case of accidents, such as falling, breaking a leg, or any other accident. So, they will have to be added to the RFL Fire Department as non-responder or an Auxiliary member. In the past we have had Auxiliary members for the Fire Department, as with the RFL Fire Cadets (youths 16-18 yrs), both programs had fallen out of use for a few years, Bobby wants to bring the Auxiliary members back to use as he did with the RFL Fire Cadets. Caryn will call Deb Barone our insurance representative to find out how much this will increase our insurance costs. This will be a benefit for all property owners in RFL.

In addition, as a follow up, Bobby informed us that Larimer County has 6 free HIZ estimates plus the physical work done for free, to follow with the HIZ. The property owner needs to agree and be in the ongoing conversation. This is for vegetation only. No trash, no tree cutting (just lower limbs) & shrubs & weeds, along with removal; this is for Zone 1 (0-5 ft from the home) & zone 2 (5 – 30 ft from the home).
