MINUTES

Meeting Called to Order: 6:08 PM

Review/Approve of May 12, 2026, Minutes: Caryn made a motion to approve the Minutes of May 12, 2026 with the two corrections, Darla 2nd the motion. All approved.

Financial Report: Caryn went through the month of May's Financial Report with us.

We have \$174,582.78 in our checking account and \$202,021.86 in our savings account for a total of \$376,604.64.

Our income for May was \$83,929.76 from taxes and interest earned.

Our expenses for May in Administration were \$8,031.92 for Insurance, County & Legal fees, Volunteer incentives, Utilities, and expendables.

Our Operating expenses for May were \$6,126.59 for training, vehicles and communications.

There were no Capitol expenses for May.

Our total expenses for May were \$14,158.51. Our Net Income was \$69,771.25.

Darla made a motion to accept the Financial Report as received, Nancy 2nd the motion, all approved.

Chief's Report:

RFL Fire Chief Brenden (Bobby) Hill was not here tonight. Gerry Wagner gave the Chief's report. This month's training was "Still water Rescue" water rescues in our area lakes. We did have 17 calls in May 13 were medical and 4 were fire related, which brings us to the end of May with 49 calls. So far, we have had 11 calls in June.

Supporter's Report:

Gerry as President of the Firehouse Supporters gave us a report on the activities of the Supporter's.

We started the month of May with \$115,898.49 we brought in \$1300.00 from check donations, \$225.00 for Fire Day booths. For an income in May of \$1,525.00. We spent \$1,739.00 to repair the old Med 1 which is now known as Med 2. Med 2 will be going to Crystal Lakes FD probably this weekend. We ended May with \$115,684.45.

The two Shuttle buses are lent by Denver University (DU) along with two drivers. Doing a continuous circle about every 15 minutes.

No Fireworks this year, but Caryn had known this earlier in May.

This year we will have a contest for the parade.

We put \$500.00 in our budget for this, but Bobby and Caryn think with the extenders to the Ambulance Bay it may go above the \$500.00. Gerry and Dan (Vice-President of the Firehouse Supporters) said the Supporters will pay for anything above the \$500.00. Michael will help with the installation.

Mark asked about the fire bans: The County is still Level 2 (no fires unless there is a on/off switch), the Forest Service (FS) you are only allowed to have fires in the FS Campground fire pits, not in the dispersed campsites. Private Property in RFL is in Larimer County-no fires!
